

R. 4 E. W.M., thence 5.0° 37'W 1370.34 H., thence 5.88° 58'E. 2584.65 H. thence 5.89° 52' E. 2661.14 ft., thence N. 1º10' E. 1316.93 ft. to the place of beginning. mains torever on all the Streets, Avenues and Alleys hereon shown. There is reserved from this above described tract the Right of Way of the Puget Sound Electric Railway. All distances are as shown on the face of this plat in feet All streets avenues and alleys are as shown.





Certificate as to the Incorporation of the Town of Facific, King County, Tash.

THIS IS TO CERTIFY That in response to a petition signed by over sixty residents of Facific, King County, Washington, filed with the Board of County Commissioners July 6th. 1909, asking for the incorporation of said Town of Pacific into a Town of the FOURTH CLASS, due and proper notice of such filing having been previously given by publication, an election was called by said Board of County Commissioners to be held on the 27th.day of July 1909, within the boundaries of said proposed corporation, for the purpose of determining the advisability of incorporating same into a town of the FCURTH CLASS, and for the election of officers for said town. Due and legal notice of such election having been given by posting notices as provided by law, and it appearing to the Board that all proceedings were regular and in accordance with the law governing such matters, the electton being held in due form, the Board did, on the 2d.day of August 1909, proceed to canvas the vote cast at said election, with the following result:

> For Incorporation. 55 votes. Against Incorporation, 9 votes. For llayor: James F. Lemar, 55 votes. For Treasurer: C.G.Simmons, 55 votes. For Members Municipal Council, C.D. Carpenter, 48 votes. C. N. Henry. 51 votes. A.H. Loof borrow. 27 votes. John Roberts, 54 votes. J.F.Lemm 45 votes. Scattering, 33 votes.

The Board did then declare PACIFIC incorporated into a Town of the FOURTH CLASS under the name and style of FACIFIC, and that the above named officers have been duly elected to fill the respective offices to serve until their successors are elected and qualified.




